

More details about inputs > What products are affected ?



Ecocert defines inputs as all of the **products involved in the process of manufacturing a certified organic farming product**, but which are not themselves subject to certification.

This includes, for example, **fertilizers, crop protection products** for plant production, **external hygiene products** for animals, and **cleaning products** for livestock buildings used for animal production.

Inputs also include **additives to food** intended for human consumption or animal production.

Finally, **oenological inputs** include products and substances that may be used or added to organic products in the wine-producing sector.
